## Sparkling

### Glass/Bottles

- PROSECCO La' Furlan doc Cuvee Beatrice NV Italy/Veneto** 12/50  
The perfect excuse to drink bubbles... lovely *Brut* Nature, dry yet fruity.
- LAMBRUSCO Curatoria Emiliana Salamino Di Santa Croce NV Italy/Emiliana** 10/42  
Lively red with violet reflections. Fruity bouquet, soft and harmonious. Taste: Light, well-balanced, easy and fun to drink.
- CREMANT DE BOURGOGNE ROSE Bailly Lappiere NV France/Burgundy** 14/58  
One breath of the fresh strawberries and cream bursting from your glass, with lovely berries, bright acidity, and light minerality this blend of 90% Pinot Noir and 10% Gamay is simply irresistible.
- CHAMPAGNE BRUT Paul Laurent NV France/Champagne** 19/90  
70% Pinot Noir/30% Chardonnay, traditional method, bright berry fruit aromas, rich mouth feeling and texture, delightfully balanced with a long clean finish.

## White Still

- MUSCADET Julien Braud Sevre-e-Maine Sur Lie 2013 France/Loire Valley** 12/50  
Pear, apple, sea spray, white flowers and crushed stone on the nose. In the mouth it's a medium body, mineral driven with slight salinity on the finish. Great with seafood, oysters and white meats.
- SOUTHERN RHONE Domaine Lafage Cote Est 2015 France/Rhone Valley *Organic*** 13/55  
Benefiting from the thermal breezes that preserve acidity, this is a lively blend of Grenache Blanc with smaller percentages of Chardonnay and Marsanne. Floral & aromatic, it's an excellent example of the friendly whites found on the Catalan coast.
- PINOT GRIGIO Peter Zemmer 2016 Italy/Alto Adige *Sustainable*** 13/55  
A rich straw-yellow color with a greenish tone, a flowery aroma and a palette of typical ripe fruit (pear, melon) and spices followed by mineral undertones and fresh acidity. Perfect with fish, shellfish, crab cakes, white meat and poultry.
- SOAVE CLASSICO Balestri Valda 2015 Italy/Veneto *Organic*** 13/55  
Unmistakable for its distinctive minerality, it fully expresses the terrior with a fresh, fruity and delightful finish.
- RIESLING Klaus Meierer Trocken Kestener 2014 Germany/Mosel *Sustainable*** 15/64  
The nose consists of lime, green apple, fresh herbs, white flowers and powered by a strong sense of petrol. On the palate it's light bodied, with high-acidity, lime, green apple, slate, hint of honey, very clean and refreshing, truly a nice one!
- RIESLING Klaus Meierer Kabinett Kestener 2015 Germany/Mosel *Sustainable*** 15/64  
An aroma of baked apples stuffed with golden raisins and cinnamon sticks, balanced with lemony tartness, a hint of Thai basil and a mineral note. The body is light and silky, with apple or peach blossoms on the palate, as well, as a hint of salinity.
- ALBARINO Castro Martin 2015 Spain/Rias Baixas *Organic*** 12/51  
Although now grown all over the world, the slopes of Rias Baixas continue to produce the best Albarino. With long family roots this wine has beautiful aromatics and a little lees contact to round out its fullness.
- GAVI Ca' Bianca Gavi 2014 Italy/Piedmont *Sustainable*** 14/60  
The 2014 Ca' Bianca Gavi DOCG is pale gold in color, complex with an intense bouquet of white flowers, honey and pears, rich and elegant, soft and mineral.
- SANCERRE Karine Lauerjat 2016 France/Loire *Sustainable*** 16/68  
Notes of gooseberry, green apple and a hint of white flowers balance beautifully. A perfect expression of Sancerre, but with a lush nose of fruit that says: this is Sauvignon Blanc at its finest. Enjoy with oysters, salads, greens and goat cheese.
- CHARDONNAY Au Bon Climat 2015 California/Santa Barbara *Organic*** 16/68  
Graceful and restrained encompassing flavors that are buttery, earthy and tropical for a well-balanced flavor with 12 months in new oak, finishing with hints of vanilla & grapefruit.
- CHARDONNAY Domaine Jomain 2014 France/Burgundy *Sustainable*** 18/77  
Starts with fruit aromas of lychee & pear while maintaining a strong fruit and acidity throughout. Produced in the commune of *Puligny-Montrachet*, this beautiful Chardonnay is a fine representative of Burgundy.

- CHARDONNAY Blue Quail 2016 California/Mendocino *Organic*** 13/55  
Fruit forward, with a bouquet of apple, pear and peach. Clean, crisp fermented in stainless steel tanks. Has a naturally acidity and a deliciously long mineral finish.
- RIOJA BLANCO Gravanoña Lopez de Heredia 2006 Spain/Rioja *Organic*** 19/81  
It's 100% Viura, aged 4-yrs. in American oak and 6-years+ in the bottle. Deep golden-yellow in color; breadly, salty, very rich, with subtle flavors of a fine Sherry. Finishing tannins add a refreshing lift.
- TXAKOLI Txomin Etxaniz 2015 Spain/Basque Country** 16/68  
Made with Hondarrabi Zuri, the primary grape of Txakoli. It's bright and fresh, with a faint sparkle that's just bursting with grapefruit and positive energy. Relentlessly refreshing.

## ROSÉ & ORANGE

- PROVENCE ROSÉ Hecht & Bannier Cotes du Provence 2016 France/Provence *Sustainable*** 15/64  
This is a Provence rosé of immense charm and minerality redolent of fennel, anise and purple flowers. Just love sipping this wine in the café with oysters, an octopus montadito or even some mixed olives. A special treat with any pairing.
- TXAKOLI ROSÉ Txomin Etxaniz 2015 Spain/Basque Country *Sustainable*** 16/68  
Txomin Etxaniz rosé is like salted watermelon juice. It's like the ocean air drifting through a raspberry bush. A divine wine for drinking all year long!
- SANCERRE ROSÉ Domaine Guillerault Fargette 2016 France/Loire *Sustainable*** 15/64  
Beautiful pale pink, with a peachy nose, red fruit on the palate, well-balanced and fully integrated with a long and lingering dry finish. Easy drinking, think warm afternoon/evening and oysters.
- RIOJA El Coto Rosado 2016 Spain/Rioja** 12/51  
Lively pale pink in color with a nose of strawberries and raspberries. Dry and easy drinking, it displays a wide range of red and dark fruits, strawberries and cherries. Versatile and ideal as an aperitif, great with salads!
- PROVENCE ROSÉ Chateau du Rouet Lili Rose 2016 France/Mediterranee *Sustainable*** 13/55  
A refreshing blend of Grenache, Carignon & Cinsault. Medium intensity, a youthful freshness, citrus and mineral notes with strawberry and cherry on the palette. A real warm weather refresher.

**“Orange wines”** are white wines aged extensively on their skins, seeds & stems, until the juice obtains a tannic character. Aging and fermentation are often done in open air, so the wine partly oxidizes; thus its distinctive burnt-orangey color. Some growers go further and utilize clay amphorae buried in the ground; others use open-top barrels. All are pursuing a highly natural, anti-technological vinification - an homage to the methods of a by-gone age. It's white wine for red wine lovers....We love 'em and hope you try 'em. If you feel the love - fantastic! If not, you've tried a piece of history.

- B VERMENTINO Tenuta La Ghiaia 2010 Italy/Liguria** 18/77  
On the nose it opens to an explosion of grapefruit and orange blossom followed by floral notes giving way to thyme and rosemary. The palate offers hints of white peach pulp, apricot and sandalwood that evolve into elegant mineral notes.
- B PINOT GRIGIO Radikon 2014 Italy/Friuli** 21/89  
Two-weeks of skin maceration and barrel aging for a year, creates a beautiful shimmering apricot colored wine with notes, flavors and textures one can find only when drinking this wine. Something different, this is it!

## Red

- BEAUJOLAIS Château de Pizay 2015 France/Beaujolais *Organic*** 12/51  
Beaujolais with the charm of Burgundy. This is especially true here with a bright fruited gem brimming with beautiful acidity and minerality.
- MERLOT Bonny Doon 2015 California/Santa Cruz *Biodynamic*** 14/60  
Delicious, elegant and plush on the palate, with dark cherry, plum and blackberry notes on the front giving way to tobacco, smoke, cherry, dark spice and black pepper with a lingering finish.
- PINOT NOIR Banshee Pinot Noir 2014 California/Napa Valley** 17/72  
This 2014 strikes a beautiful balance between both red and blue fruits, notably Bing cherry and Asian plums that are interwoven with coastal moss and fresh wild mushrooms.
- BARBERA D'ALBA Fratelli Revello 2015 Italy/Piedmont *Organic*** 15/64  
Ripe, rich silky Barbera with crushed berries and a velvety texture. A luxurious Piedmont wine that will leave you wanting more.
- RIOJA RESERVA Bodegas Muriel 2011 Spain/Rioja *Sustainable*** 14/60  
100% Tempranillo, fermented in stainless steel vats and aged for 24 months in American and French oak. Aromas of licorice and spice mingle with notes of balsamic, dark red fruit and vanilla. Full-bodied with textured tannins on the finish.
- MALBEC Luminus Allamand 2014 Argentina/Mendoza *Sustainable*** 11/47  
This wine shows a higher acidity, which is expressed through a more floral and diverse nose accompanied by a more complex and a fuller mouth feel, ripe fruit with an impressive finish.
- SYRAH Domaine de La Cendrillon Corbieres 2013 France/Languedoc-Roussillon *Sustainable*** 13/55  
The 2013 Corbieres Classique is a hidden gem that offers beautiful notes of ripe dark fruits, creamy licorice and spice in a fruit forward, layered, medium-bodied style that's just hard to resist.
- GARNATXA Dido La Universal 2015 Spain/Montsant *Organic*** 14/60  
Intense cherry color with garnet hues. Clean and very bright. Herbal touches and an abundance of fruit on the nose with a spicy and smokey base. Fresh and intense in the mouth, the expressive ripe red fruit and a long finish.
- ROSSO DI MONTALCINO La Rasina 2014 Italy/Tuscany *Sustainable*** 17/72  
This is the real deal, a family run Montalcino estate, creating a voluptuous Sangiovese with dark fruit, spice and beautiful silky tannins. This staff favorite took a few vintages off from our list, but is now back and better than ever.
- AGLIANICO Contado Riserva Di Majo Norante 2012 Italy/Molise *Sustainable*** 16/68  
Full of ripe fruit and almonds with undertones of leather and wood, its velvety texture shows well-balanced tannins and a long finish.
- BORDEAUX Château Reynier Reserve 2011 France/Bordeaux *Organic*** 15/64  
Dark deep red color, with rich berry, fruit aromas, a graceful full-bodied blend of 60% Merlot and 40% Cabernet Sauvignon with soft oak tanins, very limited estate release makes this beauty a real value.
- NEBBIOLO D'ALBA M. Morengo 2013 Italy/Piedmont *Sustainable*** 18/77  
Transparent garnet color. Aromas of cherry, rose, tar with mineral overtones. Medium body and lingering finish, full of cherry, black tea and orange peel. Tasty and a varietally correct nebbiolo.
- PRIORAT Embruix Vall Llach 2014 Spain/Priorat** 19/81  
Pronounced "Embroosh" means bewitching in Catalan; with a whiff of spice, cigar box, cocoa powder and dark berries, this Garnacha, Carinyena, Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah and Merlot blend produces a deep, rich and transporting experience.

## BY THE BOTTLE

### WHITE WINE SPARKLING

- O CAVA Cristilano Cava Brut NV Spain/Penedes** 40  
Spain's answer to grower Champagne, this small estate blends Xarello, Macabeo and Parellada from 60 year old vines. Both fruity and floral with delicate bubbles and lovely acidity, this sparkler pairs beautifully with everything.
- B PETILLANT NATUREL Johan Vineyards 2014 Oregon/Willamette** 70  
Kickback with this Pinot Noir sparkler and enjoy notes of strawberries, watermelon, blood orange, and white pepper, a cloudy pale ruby color and a yeasty, yummy froth.
- B FERRARI BRUT Fratelli Lunelli NV Italy/Trentino** (1.5L) 95  
Ferrari Brut is fresh and lasting, with significant overtones of ripe golden apples, wild flowers with a slight and pleasant ripe fruit finish with hints of bread-crust.
- CHAMPAGNE BRUT Pol Roger White Foil NV France/Epernay** 95  
If you're going to be drinking Champagne, Pol Roger is a great place to start. It's a blend of equal parts Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier. With at least 3 years in the bottle, its floral nose and toasty brioche texture make this gem worthy.
- FRANCIACORTA Antica Frata Brut NV Italy/Brusati** (375ml) 39  
90% Chardonnay, 10% Pinot Noir, fermented in temperature controlled stainless steel tanks and aged in barrel. Pale yellow in color with green highlights, the wine offers a rich mousse with a persistent bead and a clean zesty finish.
- CHAMPAGNE Ployez-Jacquemart Extra Brut France/Champagne** (375ml) 45  
55% pinot meunier, 39% chardonnay and 6% pinot noir . Bright and lively, with anise, clove and nutmeg spice notes accenting candied cherry and berry fruit. Hints of brioche, hazelnut, smoke and lemon cake add richness.
- CHAMPAGNE BRUT RESERVE Pol Roger 2000 France/Epernay** 175  
60% Pinot Noir, 40% Chardonnay, 150 years of greatness from one family! A mature vintage from Grand and Premier vineyards. The flavor is full-bodied and complex, yet sophisticated and nimble—which is their signature style.

### WHITE WINE STILL

- S GRUNER VELTLINER RESERVE Schiefer DAC Forstreiter 2014 Austria/Niederosterreich** 56  
Rich with minerals and notes of green apple, spice and citrus. This bright beauty has a surprisingly creamy mouth-feel with a long and lush finish.
- O GRUNER VELTLINER FEDERSPIEL Rudi Pichler 2014 Austria/Wachau** 68  
Powerful Veltliner from a fine vintage. Smell the white pepper, limes and pure stone. Think zing! Brilliant seafood wine.
- S RIESLING KABINETT Jean-Baptiste Gunderloch 2015 Germany/Rheinhessen** 54  
Grown in red slate, this wine balances sweetness and a plush finish. Great for salty, rich dishes.
- S RIESLING KABINETT Bernkastel Badstube Dr. Thanisch 2015 Germany/Mosel** 65  
This big full-bodied wine behaves more like a powerful Spatlese than a Kabinett, offering satisfying flavors of yellow fruits, exotic scents from a clear botrytis impact and a joyful rich but zesty finish.
- S RIESLING KABINETT von Hovel Oberemmeler Hutte 2011 Germany/Mosel** 57  
Enticing nose of pear, smoke, and spices that gives way to tropical fruit flavors balanced by spicy acidity on the palate and a long and well made finish. Light and refreshing, this is an 'easy-to-drink' style hard not to like.
- S RIESLING Red Newt Cellars Dry 2013 New York/Finger Lakes** 50  
The Finger Lakes produces rieslings in various styles from bold, dry and mineral to rich and sumptuous. This riesling shows fruit flavors of tangerine and apricot with overtones of citrus and honeysuckle. Crisp and fruity, it shows classic Finger Lakes Riesling style and sense of place.
- O RIESLING SPÄTLESE Bernkasteler Badstube J.J.Prum 2009 Germany/Mosel** 78  
Rich citrus overtones, passion fruit, melon and baked pineapple flavors. It's like lying in a hammock under a palm tree on a warm, breezy day, but with killer acid. Words like 'delicious' don't begin to describe.
- O RIESLING AUSLESE Bernkasteler Badstube J.J. Prum 2011 Germany/Mosel** 95  
A knockout of super-ripe honeyed apricots and pears, balanced with acidity, a plush mouth-feel and a long finish.

	Blessed with 40-80 year old vines, this Sauvignon Blanc boasts notes of citrus, honeysuckle and stone fruit, followed by lovely acid and mineral undertones on the palate.	
<b>S</b>	<b>BORDEAUX Chateau Nicot 2015 France/Bordeaux</b>	<b>52</b>
	More Sauvignon Blanc than Semillon and Muscadelle in this wine that teems with fruit and kisses of oak, finishing with impressions of exotic fruit and wild mint. Entre Deux Mers flaunts its stuff.	
<b>S</b>	<b>MERCUREY BLANC Chateau de Chamirey 2010 France/Burgundy</b>	<b>82</b>
	Mercurey Blanc has a delicate nose that develops citrus aromas with lime and mineral notes. On the palate this is a fresh and elegant wine with fruity aromas, white peach and notes of fresh herbs.	
<b>O</b>	<b>PETIT CHABLIS Pommier 2013 France/Burgundy</b>	<b>54</b>
	This Petit Chablis is hand-harvested and then fermented in stainless steel aging 6 months on its lees. The result is a fresh and floral nose with light fruit notes, minerality, salinity, and a clean and refreshing acidity.	
<b>S</b>	<b>CHARDONNAY Coppo Costebianche 2012 Italy/Piedmont</b>	<b>51</b>
	Pale yellow in color, with greenish reflections, Costebianche offers a fine bouquet of citrus and flowers, accented by light notes of vanilla and spice. It's soft and buttery on the palate with toasty, oak nuances and a long, finish.	
<b>O</b>	<b>POUILLY-FUISSE Terres de Vergisson Bret Brothers 2013 France/Burgundy</b>	<b>94</b>
	A beautiful, minimalist exercise in hand-crafted Chardonnay. Notes of sulfur, lemon rind, pear and white peach on the palate with a light mineral-driven finish.	
<b>S</b>	<b>POUILLY-FUISSE Le Clos Chateau de Fuisse 2011 France/Burgundy</b>	<b>140</b>
	Le Clos is extraordinarily rich with layer upon layer of ripe apple, pear, and spice. The finish is driven by minerality with a firm gripping acidity.	
<b>S</b>	<b>PULIGNY-MONTRACHET 1<sup>er</sup> CRU Les Champs Gains Chavy-Martin 2013 France/Burgundy</b>	<b>168</b>
	The low percentage of new oak allows the terroir to shine through in this beauty; elegant, sophisticated, and well-balanced with just a kiss of oak.	
<b>S</b>	<b>MEURSAULT-SANTENOTS 1<sup>er</sup> CRU Domaine Jacques Prieur 2010 France/Burgundy</b>	<b>180</b>
	This Meursault has a bouquet of stone, citrus fruit, wild flowers and a touch of anise. The palate is well balanced, rich with a powerful opening and packed with flavor. Enjoy the lingering finish with mineral and saline notes.	
<b>S</b>	<b>VOUVRAY Chateau De Valmer 2015 France/Loire</b>	<b>48</b>
	100% Chenin Blanc grown on stony slopes composed of micaceous chalk substrate. Vines are an average of 46 years of age. Fermentation in glass-lined cement tanks. There's a light golden color, with bright aromas of crisp golden apple and Anjou pear. The palate has just a hint of sweetness, with subtle mineral nuances on the finish.	
<b>O</b>	<b>SAVENNIÈRES Château d'Epiré 2014 France/Loire</b>	<b>60</b>
	Aged in old oak, bottled and left unfiltered. It's brimming with apples and honey, full-bodied and rock solid. Enjoy with shrimp and shellfish and richer salads.	
<b>O</b>	<b>CHINON BLANC Champ-Chenin Olga Raffault 1993 France/Loire</b>	<b>108</b>
	A unique expression of Chenin Blanc, this wine is earthy, dusty peaches, soft pear and a firm minerality, adding nuanced texture to an already complex wine.	
<b>O</b>	<b>XARELLO Castellroig Finca Sabate Coca SO sere 2015 Spain/Penedes</b>	<b>60</b>
	Capable of delivering the aromatics, body, and acidity, Xarel-lo represents the most favorable varietal in the Cava blend. A perfect alternative for a Chardonnay drinker.

	A staunch believer in biodynamic practices results in wines that are complex and age-worthy, with remarkable texture and structure, balanced with bracing acidity and a rich mineral finish.

## RED WINE

- S CABERNET FRANC Dedicato a Walter Poggio al Tessaro 2008 Italy/Tuscany 158**  
 Perfectly interwoven aromas of black berried fruit, pepper and balsamic with hints of eucalyptus. The palate astonishes for its ability to sustain this imposing structure with a light tautness, making it both powerful and agile.
- S CROZES-HERMITAGE Domaine des Lises 2014 France/Northern Rhône 79**  
 Maxime Graillet produces wines that express both the varietals and terroir. His Crozes-Hermitage is a bright, sappy, juicy, red fruited wine with a driving rocky twist and terrific spice.
- S CORNAS Nicolas Serette 2014 France/Northern Rhône 92**  
 If there is such a thing as “subtlety” in Cornas, it’s found here. An intricate wine with a mineral character and ripeness that lurks underneath. A great funk rules above all in this vintage.
- CÔTE RÔTIE Les Journaries Bernard Levet 2012 France/Northern Rhône 116**  
 Grown on ludicrously steep slopes, are grapes that form a savory, classic peppery wine. Of course, olives and some seriously meaty chew are a must have. A salt of the earth power-house., for lovers of Côte Rôtie.... a real treat.
- S CORNAS Brise Cailloux Domaine du Coulet 2012 France/Northern Rhône 130**  
 We call this “fresh” or “bright” for Cornas, but we’d be dumbing it down. So generous on the palate, but it’s the nose you’ll keep talking about. “We could smell this for hours” we said... and we did.
- S CHÂTEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE Domaine Charvin 2012 France/Rhône 145**  
 There are no secrets here, simply old vines, very low yields and minimal winemaking intervention to create this phenomenal wine. A seductive bouquet of raspberry and cherry preserves, dried herbs, fresh lavender and light leather notes give way to deep fruit and lush tannins, with a finish that lingers seemingly forever.
- S CHÂTEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE Domaine de Cristia 2014 France/Rhône 98**  
 It’s a blend of 80% Grenache, 15% Syrah and 5% Mourvedre, from 50-100 year-old vines, the wine possesses a seductive bouquet of kirsch, black currants, licorice, incense, lead and pencil shavings.
- S GIGONDAS Domaine du Cayron France/Southern Rhône 88**  
 70% Grenache, 15% each Syrah and Cinsault and a drop of Mourèdre, phenomenal richness and incredible longevity. Their vines yield bold red berry fruit and one of the most terrior-expressive wines in the Southern Rhone.
- B PINOT NOIR Alois Lageder 2013 Italy/Alto Adige 58**  
 The Lageder family has been making wine for five generations; their Pinot Noir is lush with notes of rich earth, red fruit, dark cherries, spice and mild herbaceous notes.
- B PINOT NOIR P Fritsch 2011 Austria/Niederosterreich 98**  
 This Pinot Noir is subtle with seductive wild cherry notes on the nose. The body is luscious, well-rounded, generous and inviting, without an ounce of fat. Enjoy hints of clove and anise with a deep, mellow cherry core at the finish.
- O CRU BEAUJOLAIS George Descombes Morgon 2015 France/Burgundy 71**  
 A brilliant red Gamay. Fresh red fruits, pungent flowers on the perfumed nose, with a slowly emerging mineral element. Lively and focused on the palate, showing good lift to the red currant and bitter cherry flavors. Finishes clean and nervy.
- O PINOT NOIR Catherine & Claude Marechal, 2014 France/Burgundy 79**  
 Absolutely joyous, displaying a perfume of sweet cherries with an floral lift. It’s impressively concentrated with a caressing mouthfeel that’s fleshy and supple with attractive brightness. This is very fine, authentic red Burgundy.
- S PINOT Noir Domaine Chevrot, Santenay 1er Cru Clos Rousseau 2014 France/Burgundy 100**  
 Wonderful focus and lifted fruit in this Santenay with silky tannins. From 50 year-old vines. Silty, clay soil on a limestone table. 40% whole cluster fermentation. Aged 12 months in barrels of 0-5 years, 30% new.
- S MARSANNAY Les Boivin Domaine Coillot 2011 France/Burgundy 122**  
 There’s a bright fruit notes and fresh cinnamon spice on the nose, which continues on the palate with soft well integrated tannins. Marsannay has one of the coolest climates in France for a red wine.
- B CORTON-BRESSANDES Grand Cru Domaine Chandon de Briailles 2011 France/Burgundy 158**  
 Claude de Nicolay’s ultra-natural, exquisitely balanced Corton; no new oak or manipulation and an amazing Asian spice nose.



- O CHAMBOLLE-MUSIGNY 1<sup>er</sup> CRU Les Sentiers Domaine Anne & Herve Sigault 2011 France/Burgundy 164**  
On the nose there's wild berries, currant, plum, violet and earthen aromas that erupt from the glass with an intoxicating bouquet. The palate is supple and well-rounded with a taut muscularity and a lingering finish where a touch of wood surfaces to round out this phenomenal wine.
- S PINOT NOIR Occidental 2013 California/Sonoma Coast 175**  
Light reddish purple color in the glass. The dreamy aromas of cherry pie and brown baking spices are intoxicating. On the palate there's black cherry and black raspberry fruits with a steely acidity. Impressive finish and length.
- S GEVREY-CHAMBERTIN 1<sup>er</sup> CRU Poissenot Domaine Humbert Freres 2011 France/Burgundy 186**  
The nose is alive with currant, red cherry and licorice notes among the dried earth and smoke. The palate is muscular for Burgundy, but continues to show refinement and polish on a finish that seems to last and last.
- S VOLNAY-SANTENOTS 1<sup>er</sup> CRU Domaine Jacques Prieur 2011 France/Burgundy 200**  
It is perfumed with deep red-berried fruit, violets, spice and warm earth scents giving way to a seductively textured and attractively energetic wine. Rich fruit, with notes of leather, earth, cocoa and anise glide to a finish with lush tannins.
- GRAVES Château Picque Caillou 2012 France/Bordeaux 78**  
From the town of Bordeaux itself in the Pessac-Leognan appellation within Graves. Château Haut Brion neighbors this estate, giving a similar cedar, dusty, terroir signature. This is an under-the-radar, classic, delicious claret.
- PAUILLAC Château Tour Pibran 2011 France/Bordeaux 92**  
A second label is a value of values, with neighbors like Mouton-Rothschild & Lynch-Bages. Only 17 hectares of vines tended to with care produces a brawny steak-wine with bold fruit, tobacco undertones and firm tannins.
- S ST. ESTEPHE Chateau La Peyre 2010 France/Bordeaux 108**  
Cabernet Sauvignon 50%, Merlot 40%, Petit Verdot 5% and Cabernet Franc 5% release a nose of pencil shavings, forest floor aromas with black cherry and anise. On the palate, a smooth, rounded finish with fully developed tannins.
- POMEROL Clos Beauregard 2011 France/Burgundy 132**  
Their 2011 vintage is a blend of 93% Merlot, 4% Cabernet Sauvignon, and 3% Cabernet Franc. The wine is big and bold with rich, layered notes of plum, cherry, cocoa, tobacco and spice.
- S ST JULIEN Chateau Gloria 2010 France/Bordeaux 155**  
This 2010 vintage has ample ripe blackberry, chocolate, spice and espresso. The blend of 66% Cabernet Sauvignon, 28% Merlot and 6% Petit Verdot is ready to enjoy now and also has the depth and structure to improve for years to come.
- O OVERTURE Opus One NV California/Napa Valley 180**  
Overture is the non-vintage second wine of Opus One. Aged in French oak, and on the nose there's sweet vanilla, black cherry and cassis with hints of tobacco. A lively mouth-feel that gives way to a velvet finish indicative of Opus One.
- O CABERNET SAUVIGNON Sixteen 600 2013 California/Sonoma Valley 195**  
Phil Couturri's classic California cab. The long barrel age softens the tannins but the neutral oak keeps this pretty grippy with cassis, tobacco, bright fruit and minerality. The caramelized vanilla and oak-based flavors leave a lingering finish.
- O OPUS ONE Opus One 2012 California/Napa Valley 300**  
The 2012 vintage is 79% Cabernet Sauvignon, 7% Cabernet Franc, 6% Petit Verdot, 6% Merlot, and 2% Malbec. Dark fruit aromas accentuated by subtle notes of forest-floor and graphite gives way to a round mouth-feel and satiny tannins that wrap around cassis, blackberry and black cherry on the palate. This refined and age-worthy wine offers lively acidity, a sturdy structure and a long lingering finish.
- S RIBERA DEL DUERO El Pedrosal Viña Pedrosa 2013 Spain/Ribera del Duero 55**  
Aged in French and American oak barrels, comes 100% Tinto Fino; with concentrated black cherries, figs, amazing structure and a super-long finish.
- O RIBERA DEL DUERO Viñedos Valderiz 2011 Spain/Ribera del Duero 72**  
Simply an awesome wine, hand-harvested from 70 year old vines, generous with powdery tannins and a gloriously long finish. The 2011 is Ribera in all its sexy, hot weathered glory: strong, concentrated, with underlying earth and richness.
- O RIOJA RESERVA Tondonia Lopez de Heredia 2004 Spain/Rioja 95**  
A luscious aroma of asian spices and black fruits greet the nose before unfurling into flavors of dark berry fruit, cigar box, mushroom and plum. If you're looking for a taste of Spanish royalty, start here.

- O RIOJA CRIANZA La Montesa Palacios Remondo 2011 Spain/Rioja (1.5ml) 99**  
Spanish winemaker of the year in 2008, Alvaro Palacios makes wine that flows velvety smooth, with notes of orange rind, fresh cherries and rosemary petals that culminate in a long and evocative finish.
- O RIBEIRA TINTO Eidos Ermos Luis Anxo Rodriguez Vazquez 2014 Spain/Ribeira 56**  
Luis Rodriguez, a beloved winemaker in Spain, creates a blend of six native varietals for a fruit-driven wine...lush with red fruit, pepper, balsamic and smoke.
- K/O MONTSANT Peraj Petita Celler de Capcanes 2013 Spain/Montsant 58**  
A delicious kosher wine from the land surrounding the famous Priorat. A side project from the prominent Capcanes crew blending Garnacha, Carignan, and Tempranillo to produce a fruit forward sensual treat.
- O PRIORAT Clos Fontà Mas d'En Gil 2008 Spain/Priorat 138**  
From old vines, Clos Fontà is a blend of Grenache and Carignan aged in French oak producing black fruit and spice. Voluptuous with exotic floral bouquet and endless fruit, the wine embraces you in a warm, comforting hug.
- O/B PRIORAT Les Terrasses-Vielles Vignes Alvaro Palacios 2014 Spain/Priorat 112**  
Small, dynamic wine region in north-eastern Spain, whose intense, full-bodied red wines have shot to fame in the past few decades. This classic Priorat wine is made from old-vine Garnacha and Cariñena, and has concentrated aromas of licorice, tar and brandied cherries
- S CHIANTI CLASSICO Badia a Coltibuono 2014 Italy/Tuscany 54**  
The Chianti Classico has layers of iris, violet, tobacco, black pepper and cherry on the nose. The wine is well balanced and well-integrated with supple tannins, mineral notes, and a mouth cleansing fresh acidity.
- B VINO NOBILE DI MONTELPUCIANO Avignonesi 2013 Italy/Tuscany 69**  
This Vino Nobile produces intense aromas of red fruit, earth and spice. On the palate, full-bodied and complex with fine balance, offering a tobacco and spice lingering finish.
- O BRUNELLO DI MONTALCINO Le Chiuse 2010 Italy/Tuscany 128**  
The sensuous side of Brunello, with elaborate fruit and bold flavors, from cherry to cocoa to sweet pipe tobacco. This wine sings with firm, salty cheeses and charcuterie.
- O MONTECUCCO SANGIOVESE RISERVA Lombrone Castello Colle Massari 2008 Italy/Tuscany 155**  
One of the best grapes grown, the wine is bright and polished with notes of dark cherries, red fruit, violet and sweet spices. Silky tannins and a long finish will keep you coming back for more.
- O BAROLO Armando Parusso 2011 Italy/Piedmont 150**  
Huge...on the nose it reveals a fruity mélange of raspberry, plums, apricot, peach, earthy and underbrush notes. On the palate its a full bodied, muscular with great velvet tannin. Long and persistent finish.
- S BARBARESCO Cascina Luisin 2010 Italy/Piedmont 125**  
This wine is known for great elegance and austerity of classic Nebbiolo, displaying delicate fruit and age worthy tannins.
- S BARBARESCO Borgogno Serio & Battista 2013 Italy/Piedmont 88**  
Garnet red, full and fruity, reminiscent of violets and geraniums, complemented with spicy notes of cinnamon and tobacco. It's round and well-balanced with elegant tannins, notes of ripe red fruit, hints of spices followed with a long and soft finish.
- S BAROLO Marziano Abbona Cerviano 2010 Italy/Piedmont 108**  
Deep ruby red, with garnet reflections. On the nose, notes of graphite and gun powder, followed by nuance of fruit alcohol, dried rose and herbs. The palette is robust, important, full and fleshy, with an eye-opening power.
- S BAROLO Marziano Abbona Pressenda 2011 Italy/Piedmont 120**  
Great structure and drinkability. Its flavors evolve from mint and violet to raspberry and spices. In the mouth its solid and persistent.
- S BAROLO Marziano Abbona Terlo Ravera 2009 Italy/Piedmont 130**  
This is a beautiful Barolo, bursting with pure cherry and raspberry fruit, accented by floral, tobacco and earth notes. Balanced and intense, shows no shortage of ripe tannins for support. Delivers fine length and a minerally element on the finish
- S BAROLO Ravara G.D. 2010 Vajra Italy/Piedmont 136**  
The nose reveals freshly cut flowers, mint and sweet spices to add lift, but ultimately this is a dark, brooding Barolo with sweet, rich and ripe fruit. In near-perfect balance, these tannins will allow this vintage to age for years to come!

- S**      **BAROLO Gavarini Chiniera Elio Grasso 2011 Italy/Piedmont**      **174**  
 This 2011 Barolo has sweet floral and spice notes that meld into bright red stone fruits and mint, all supported by fine, chalky tannins that give the wine its sense of energy and tension.
- S**      **BAROLO Monprivato Giuseppe Mascarello 2010 Italy/Piedmont**      **215**  
 This wine is a generous, dramatic Barolo with a very long fermentation and 3 yrs in old Slovenian oak. The Mascarello name can speak for itself. A supremely powerful wine.
- B**      **SICILIA ROSSO SP68 Occhipinti 2015 Italy/Sicily**      **70**  
 From south-west Sicily, this Nero d'Avola & Frappato blend has dark berries and joyful acidity for an incredible result.
- O**      **TAURASI Cantine Lonardo 2009 Italy/Campania**      **104**  
 The 2009 Taurasi is dark, sensual and impeccably layered, with plenty of fruit, hints of smoke, tobacco and licorice for a long finish.
- S**      **AMARONE DELLA VALPOLICELLA CLASSICO Marchiopo 2004 Italy/Valpolicella**      **140**  
 Marchiopo creates a product of exceptional quality utilizing native Italian varietals for the quintessential Amarone, displaying a rich combination of raisinated fruit, with chocolate and espresso dancing among a leathery earth. Spoil yourself!
- O**      **BEKAA VALLEY Hochar Pere et Fils Château Musar 2001 Lebanon/Bekaa Valley**      **70**  
 A Cinsault, Carignon, Cabernet Sauvignon and Granache blend offers notes of dried cranberries, leather, tea leaves, balsamic, cigar box and sweet, dried fruit like plums and figs. Layers of flavors and acidity are supported by firm but velvety tannins.
- K**      **JUDEAN HILLS Classico Flam Winery 2013 Israel/Judean Hills**      **75**  
 Their 2013 Bordeaux blend is lush with layers of herbs and ripe fruit, complex notes of spice, and finishes with notes of vanilla and cacao.

If you've never tried a true Sherry-type wine before, this is a "safe space" to try one. The Fino and Amontillado are great as dry appetizer wines and with cheese. The darker Oloroso and Palo Cortado are excellent with meats and cheeses. The sweet ones are like drinking a box of chocolate caramels! Give one a chance, you deserve it.

## Sherry

- FINO SHERRY En Rama Tio Pepe Gonzalez-Byass Spain/Xeres** 11  
Dry, bracing, and nutty, leading to mild floral and honey hints up front with apple notes, and a finish that leaves you craving cheese and olives.
- SHERRY AMONTILLADO Dios Baco Spain/Xeres** 10  
Made like Fino/Manzanilla, then aged in wood to achieve a nutty, off-dry, complex taste. A versatile aperitif for nuts, olives, charcuterie, cheeses; irresistible with mushrooms.
- SHERRY PALO CORTADO Leonor Gonzalez-Byass Spain/Xeres** 11  
The rarest form of all Sherries, Palo Cortado is also the most natural in that it cannot be 'made' as such. Intense nutty aroma of toasted hazelnuts and almonds with some spicy character on the palate. A very long and smooth finish.
- SHERRY OLOROSO Dios Baco Spain/Xeres** 10  
Darker, nuttier, richer, roasted flavor and still dry at the finish. Perfect after-dinner with rich cheeses.
- SHERRY PEDRO XIMENEZ DULCE Nectar Gonzalez-Byass Spain/Xeres** 11  
Rich, sweet and velvety smooth Sherry shows complex flavors of caramel, dried fruits, figs, chocolate, nuts and spices and is a perfect match for any sweet dessert.

## Port & Madiera

- CRUSTED PORT Churchill's Tawny Portugal/Oporto** 14  
A blend of full-bodied Ports from recent vintages, matured in cask for 12 to 18 months, bottled without filtration, then aged 3 years in bottle. A special Port with the distinctive dry finish.
- TAWNY PORT 20 Year Quinta do Infantado Portugal/Douro** 16  
The 20yr is complex and full-bore tawny, with intense flavors of orange cream, glazed apricot, baked peach and roasted pineapple that are balanced by concentrated chocolate and toffee notes. The bright finish is filled with spice and supported by fresh acid.
- MADEIRA Barbeito Single Harvest 2003 Portugal/Madeira** 16  
Colonial America's most popular beverage, said to be the inspiration for those ruffians who wrote the Declaration of Independence. Vibrant, nutty, salty, lightly sweet, deepened by its extensive sleep in barrel and bottle.

## Sweet

- COTEAUX DU LAYON Chaume Domaine de la Soucherie 2007 France/Loire** 15  
Luscious, honeyed Chenin Blanc from the best parcel of this superb estate established in 1780. Deep apple and lemon drop flavors hover about a greenish-golden fire at its core.
- COMMANDARIA ST JOHN Keo Cyprus/Keo** 13  
The oldest wine brand in the world! Rich with raisins, apricots other dried fruit; strong but not cloying. Perfect with or as dessert.
- OREMUS, Tokaji Aszu 3 Puttonyos 2010 Hungary/Bajcsy** 21  
100% Furmint varietals showing an exciting spicy/sweet character of this Hungarian grape. The Late Harvest Furmint is has 40 to 50% of the grapes having succumbed to noble rot (Aszu in Hungarian), giving concentrated sugars and a botrytis complexity. A wonderful way to end a meal or evening.
